2. Background check -

All coaches must provide a criminal record extract (Bulletin no. 5). For EIDE coaches, both Bulletin no. 3 and Bulletin no. 5 are required.

We conduct background checks on all coaches who work regularly with children to ensure their safety and protection.

To this end, we ask you to present an extract from your criminal records along with your ID card. These extracts can easily be requested via MyGuichet.

Please note that we will not retain the extract or your ID card; we only need to verify them and record that you are cleared to work with underage children.
